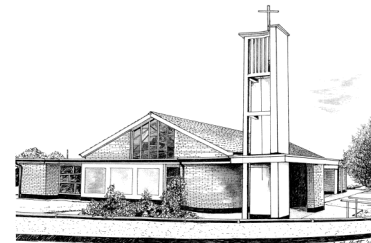

REFLECTION - Eucharistic Life



In the last few weeks we have taken a brief detour from Mark's Gospel and spent time savouring the Eucharistic readings from the Gospel of John. As each week passes, we have been gradually led into a fuller understanding of Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist.

What began with a small child carrying bread and fish has now developed into a theological exposition of Jesus' invitation to eat his flesh and drink his blood.....and hearing that for the first time would have been something to think about at length.

We can imagine how, in their efforts to absorb this mystery more fully each word was carefully chosen and prayed through by the early Christian community - and like us, they led busy lives. Today, like them, we want to understand the Eucharistic mystery, knowing that at journey's end, we have barely scratched the surface.

What *does* it mean to lead a Eucharistic life? To begin with, it means what each of us is doing right now - being actively present in this faith community to celebrate Eucharistic more fully. And, what is most essential, it means that we step out from this Church in faith to give our lives in service. (*Kathryn Williams pddm*)

Pope Francis urges a restless search, like that of Augustine of Hippo, a "restlessness of heart that led him to a personal encounter with Christ, leads us to understand that the God he was looking for outside of himself is the very God who is near to everybody, the God close to our heart, nearer to us than our own selves."
