## **REFLECTION - On Sheep and Shepherds**

Sheep, lambs and shepherds are part of my Kiwi psyche. My childhood memories are of hundreds of sheep dotted on hills, slow moving cars winding through slower moving sheep and even slower moving shepherds. And then there was the orphan lamb that became my pet. The remarkable thing about this creature was the way that he knew my voice above all the other voices, he knew my steps, he knew the hands that fed him.... and he absolutely refused to follow anyone else.



Jesus noticed these sorts of things about sheep. Sheep and shepherds were a big part of his psyche too. From the day of his birth until his death (and even afterwards) images of lambs, sheep and shepherds pop up frequently. Mary would have pointed out to the small child on her knee all the biblical passages about sheep and shepherds.... From the shepherd psalm to the lamb which was led to slaughter. Jesus would have watched the shepherds tending their flocks, noticing the way they had favourite names for each one and he would have stored it all in him memory.

As we listen to today's Gospel, we might learn anew about the way each of us is a favourite of Jesus; he knows our voice and he knows our steps. We are destined to be with him forever. (*Kathryn Williams pddm*)
